

- Dates, 1500+ Friday 11 1400 Sunday 13 June 2021. This is the Queens birthday long weekend for some States and ACT with Monday 14 a public holiday to stay on or travel day for some.

Location, Condobolin NSW. The main rally registration, event and ride start/return point is the Riverview Caravan Park (https://www.lachlan.nsw.gov.au/community/caravan-parks/riverview-caravan-park.aspx) that has a mix of onsite cabins, ensuite donga's and tent sites. What to See in Condobolin

For those that have not had enough riding or need a break from socialising then why not check out https://www.condobolin.nsw.au/:

Gum Bend Lake

A visit to Gum Bend Lake, an artificial lake three kilometres from Condobolin and when full is 1.75 metres deep. Opened on 22 October 1988, Gum Bend Lake was a project to commemorate Australia's bicentenary and was jointly funded by the NSW Bicentennial Council, the people of Condobolin and the Lachlan Shire Council. For further information on Gum Bend Lake click here.

Caution: this lake leaks to the North/West exiting on to Kiacatoo Road and over very soft mud, as tested by the organiser and MU-X (\$250 tow). There is a track running parallel to the Lachlan River. So pick your route or take a friend.

The Lachlan River

The Lachlan River is responsible for much of the Heart of NSW landscape. To experience the history and beauty of this iconic inland river, visitors can admire the

Mt Tilga - Heart of NSW

Mount Tilga is eight kilometres north of Condobolin on the Melrose Rd and originally known in the 1800s as the geographical centre of NSW. Enjoy the environment at the base of the mountain, or for the more adventurous, you may wish to climb to the summit for panoramic 360-degree views of the Lachlan Valley. Railway Museum

The Condobolin Railway Museum at Madline Street Condobolin is a must – see for train buffs. It houses a diverse collection of old trikes, trailers and railway items as well as other pieces including old motors and horse drawn machinery donated by local people.

Lachlander Museum

The Lachlander Museum at 46 Bathurst Street Condobolin printed their newspaper on one of the last operational hot metal printing presses in Australia up until January 2004. All of the equipment previously used is complete and available for inspection by appointment at the Lachlander Museum. Machinery includes three presses and two intertype machines. Overnight Trip to GOOMERI

15-16th May

For those looking for a reason to travel, here's a ride report for a trip I organised last Saturday and Sunday for the Gold Coast BMW Club, they came up from exit 54 to meet at Caboolture. Not sure all the roads would be fun in car or with passengers that don't like corners, but you can find other near-by roads that are straighter. I would also visit some of the wineries if I was in a car, but on a bike we are teetotal until the bikes are tucked into bed for the night.

Many of you know that I having been keen on the Goomeri bakery for a while and this weekend 13 other intrepid souls ventured up from the Gold Cost to do a nearly 900km round trip to check it out.

Based in Brisbane, I arranged to meet at The Revolution Coffee shop in Caboolture at 8am, some of the "boys" seemed very at home in the 1960's styled lounges (Photo bottom left front page). From there up to Mt Mee via Bellmere Road, Old North Road and Campbells Pocket Road. The plan was

to fuel at Kilcoy after avoiding Woodford by using Delaney's Creek Road, with recent rain I wasn't sure if there was surface damage to the short distance of gravel. There was obvious relief on the faces of Mike Skidmore and Adrian & Cherie Headon as they don't seem to like my idea of a bit of Gravel. (It is very good smooth gravel, but their bikes don't like any gravel)

Heading Northwest toward Kingaroy, I am always amazed at the amount of retained embankments near Benarkin, unfortunately they have dropped the speed limits otherwise it would have been great with those big sweeping corners. Lunch was at the Blackbutt Bakery, as always the pies sell themselves.



We were making great time and an early arrival was likely, this was mentioned several times by Cherie that we could have left later and she could have got more sleep in, but I think the general consensus was, we were all happy to ride and the sooner the better (or that's my story and I am sticking to it).

Rather than just head up the highway, we went via Barambah and drove past wineries and olive groves, then into Goomeri. The arrival was a tad early, so we went and checked out Joes Commercial Hotel (the Goomeri Pub). Fortunately their beers were cold and fresh so no complaints there. The few minutes I spent planning this ride were on display as there were a number of Vintage Model T vehicles there having a meeting, what an amazing bit of working engineering to see.



After returning to the Goomeri motel (we booked out all 10 rooms, so I think they will be happy to see us a again another time), a few restorative drinks were in order as Cherie once again mentioned that the early departure could have been avoided, this is noted for the next time.



Dinner at Joes' was up to its normal great standard and the recent Dusty Hills vintage (the winery is owned by the Publican) seemed to go down well, although I am not sure the bottles were really filled to the 750ml line as we seemed to need a few.

Breakfast was to be at the bakery at 8am, some ventured down earlier, for those that can't do a pastry or i.e. for breakfast, there was a café next door.

Mike Skidmore, Iwan and 2 others were adding in an

extra day and were going to do a recce of Ban Ban springs, Harvey Bay and back to Goomeri.

The rest were going to head toward Gympie then south over whatever winding roads we could find.

Coming into Kilkivan, Adrian had to pull over and add air to his front tyre, this I suspect was a ruse to show Cherie how he had mastered the art of having the right gear with him (and knowing how to use it) after the less than perfect application on the TS Safari where 4 of us had to help him out with various advice or equipment that he didn't have. Suf-



fice to say, he's got it all now, Cherie just complains there's less room for her gear.

Steve, was keen to take the straighter faster route and this suit Grayden and Jill, so they left us as we headed off the main route toward Widgee. Sweeping country roads had us coming into the outskirts of Gympie in no time and the magic of Google had us skirt it and onto the Mary Valley Highway.



I had thought the rattler café was at Kandanga, but can report it is actually back in Amamoor, except it's not called the red rattler but some other cafe name, but it sits adjacent to the Amamoor train station. Parked and ready for a coffee, my arse lucky streak kicked in again and the red rattler steam train came into view, fortunately we had already ordered coffee, so we could watch the swarm of people exit the train and head our way. Watching the old train decouple, head forward and shunt to go the rear of the train was interesting, but watching the clever engineering in the turntable where they used the steam of the engine to power a small wheel that turned the turntable was brilliant. Job done in under 2 minutes and not one stop/go person insight. Coffee done, it was time to complete the run via Imbil and Kenilworth before a short rider briefing at Conondale to explain the "dips" on the post-

man tack and then the tightening turns on the Bellthorpe Road. Well the route certainly met the number of turns criteria.

Caution note, Postman's Track is not suitable for low slung cars

The final route home was via Somerset and then for the Gold Coast contingent led by Erik Lorenzen, they went via Boonah and Beaudesert. For me, I went over Mt Glorious and home. I clocked 663km, I am sure the others did quite a few more.

Excellent group to ride with and what a great "shakedown ride" ahead of my departure to Townsville on Wednesday to make it by Saturday PM for the start on Sunday night of the GS Safari to Cairns.






