## Advancetown history

Beneath the waters of the Hinze Dam lies the site of the original settlement of Advancetown. Above the water level, sits the newer township of the same name.

### Hinze Dam

By the time construction was completed on the Hinze Dam in 1977, the Advancetown school had long closed, the timber industry had declined and farming residents had relocated to other areas. The original settlement of Advancetown and surrounding areas was submerged under the waters of the Hinze Dam and a new township was established above the waters of the lake.

# PRESIDENT'S REPORT


May 2021

Attached to this email is the NMR21 and 3 host clubs logo and event information for your website, event page and magazine editor's use. We have included some key information and leave the layout and format to your Club's discretion, but ask and encourage you to distribute this information within your respective Clubs:

- NMR21 is open to financial members and their partners (guests) of Official BMW Clubs. It is not open to non-members or the general motorcycle rallying community.
- Dates, 1500+ Friday 11 - 1400 Sunday 13 June 2021. This is the Queens birthday long weekend for some States and ACT with Monday 14 a public holiday to stay on or travel day for some.

Location, Condobolin NSW. The main rally registration, event and ride start/return point is the Riverview Caravan Park (<https://www.lachlan.nsw.gov.au/community/caravan-parks/riverview-caravan-park.aspx>) that has a mix of onsite cabins, ensuite donga's and tent sites. Condobolin has a number of pubs and motels within the town and listed on the NMR21 Event Information sheet (attached and subject to change, so use the event page link). Registrants need to book, pay for and responsible for their own accommodation including cancellations.

- Rallyists need to register and if attending the gala dinner at Condobolin RSL Saturday 12th night select their meal 3 course options listed when registering. The RSL is licensed, so purchase your drinks at the bar, there is *NO BYO*. This will be a ticketed dinner, so no ticket (@ registration) no entry. There is also an optional, ticketed, Friday 11 welcome BBQ and Sunday 13 farewell breakfast at the Riverview Caravan Park.
- Condobolin has plenty of things to see and do, and we are planning some self/guided rides for those who haven't had enough riding on Saturday. NSW licensed fishers can try their luck in the Lachlan River and enter the 'catch & release' fishing competition, yes we will be checking your proof. The NMR21 raffle proceeds will be donated to a community charity.

### What to See in Condobolin

#### Gum Bend Lake

A visit to Gum Bend Lake, an artificial lake three kilometres from Condobolin and when full is 1.75 metres deep. Opened on 22 October 1988, Gum Bend Lake was a project to commemorate Australia's bicentenary and was jointly funded by the NSW Bicentennial Council, the people of Condobolin and the Lachlan Shire Council. *Caution: this lake leaks to the North/West exiting on to Kiacatoo Road and over very soft mud, as tested by the organiser and MU-X (\$250 tow). There is a track running parallel to the Lachlan River. So pick your route or take a friend.*

#### The Lachlan River

The Lachlan River is responsible for much of the Heart of NSW landscape. To experience the history and beauty of this iconic inland river, visitors can admire the

### **Mt Tilga – Heart of NSW**

Mount Tilga is eight kilometres north of Condobolin on the Melrose Rd and originally known in the 1800s as the geographical centre of NSW. Enjoy the environment at the base of the mountain, or for the more adventurous, you may wish to climb to the summit for panoramic 360-degree views of the Lachlan Valley. ### **Railway Museum**

The Condobolin Railway Museum at Madline Street Condobolin is a must – see for train buffs. It houses a diverse collection of old trikes, trailers and railway items as well as other pieces including old motors and horse drawn machinery donated by local people.

### **Lachlander Museum**

The Lachlander Museum at 46 Bathurst Street Condobolin printed their newspaper on one of the last operational hot metal printing presses in Australia up until January 2004. All of the equipment previously used is complete and available for inspection by appointment at the Lachlander Museum. Machinery includes three presses and two intertype machines. Lets take the opportunity to travel with our friends either on bikes or in cars to places that lift the spirit, we owe it to our friends, family and the areas we go into




