





Saddle Fitness Training Camp 2nd January 2020

The need to buy a new 1250 GSA came about because my son, Cameron, mentioned he would like to ride with me to Craigs Hut in Mt Stirling. He has always loved the Man from Snowy River movies



and who was I not to encourage him with this idea. Of course the planets aligned and BMW are doing a Safari near there in late March, about the time we were going to go, so I signed us both up.

Cameron has plenty of dirt bike experience, but I wanted to make sure he was comfortable on 265kg of bike and the dis-

tances that we often do, day in day out. To that end, we cobbled together a 2 day ride over MT Mee and the scenic back roads to

Gympie, then around to Kilkivan and overnight at Joes Commercial Hotel, Goomeri.

Our next stop was Esk, where Peter had arranged to get a lift home with his Dad, the total of 850km was much more than he had expected and was




he happy to climb into a car seat and stretch out.
